## TEAM D - DAY OF Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 JUNE 2022 CIRCUIT DE GRAND COURONNE LES ESSARTS ORIVAL GENERAL RULES

### Article 1: Definition

The weekend of the annual TEAM J club gathering is a friendly gathering open to motorbikes and sidecars, including demonstrations on the ROUEN Les Essarts circuit (76).

### Article 2: Organization

The days of June 5 and 6, 2022 are organized by the association "TEAM J" association law 1901. Participants and visitors are requested to strictly observe the instructions given by the organizing team, both inside the parks and on the circuit. Ember barbecues are strictly prohibited (forestry).

### Article 3: Vehicles admitted

This event is open to all owners of cars, motorcycles and sidecars. The organizer reserves the right to hire vehicles of an exceptional nature. A selection will take place on Saturday May 7.

### Article 4: Registrations

Sending the registration form implies acceptance by the participant of these rules without any reservation. The fact of registering implies to each participant to respect the instructions given on site by the organizer. Given the limited number of participants, the organizer reserves the right to refuse registrations, as well as vehicles which do not correspond to the spirit of the event, without having to justify it. (Priorities for vehicles: competition old cars, exceptional cars with great historical or character. interest).

Participants must hold a valid driver's license, not suspended or canceled, corresponding to the vehicle brought, and present the original on the day of the event.

### Article 5: Demonstrations

Each participant is given the opportunity to ride on the Essarts circuit, in his own vehicle. After acceptance by the organizer, the registration is firm and non-refundable in case of withdrawal of the participant.

### Article 6: Access to the track

The organizer will carry out a visual technical check, and reserves the right to refuse the departure to any vehicle whose condition or appearance is not in accordance with safety rules, it being understood that each participant is responsible for the condition of his vehicle. The organizer will identify the participant and the vehicle entered for the duration of the event. The signatory of the entry form will be the only person authorized to drive the entered machine.

### Article 7: Security

For bikers, wearing a helmet and full leather clothing, gloves and boots are mandatory, (exceptionally, jeans will be tolerated if the weather conditions are favorable). The organizer reserves the right to refuse the start to any vehicle having suffered damage during the event.

For sidecars a passenger is accepted, for a minimum compared to the standard vehicle wearing a helmet will be compulsory for the driver and his passenger. Any offender will be excluded from access to the track without the possibility of compensation.

### Article 8: Passengers

No passenger is authorized on two wheels except a club authorized to perform baptisms by the organizer. For sidecars a passenger is accepted, for single passenger cars which will be the responsibility of the driver. Prohibited for at least 10 years, the identity card may be requested.

### Article 9: Parking, traffic

Visitors and participants will submit to and respect the signs and signs for the various parking lots and locations indicated on the Essarts circuit. Any movement must be made at a reduced pace. The organizer reserves the right to immediately exclude any participant whose behavior is considered dangerous.

### Article 10: Insurance - Damage – Theft

The organization takes out insurance for bodily injury, material damage to the organization, consequential non-material. The participants declare that they discharge the organizers of all responsibility arising from the use of their vehicles, under any conditions whatsoever, both on the track and in the park. **It is therefore up to each participant to personally provide cover for the risks they run and their own civil liability.** The organizer declines any responsibility for damage or theft occurring to parked vehicles and any exposed element, within the framework of the event.

### Article 11: Complaints

No complaint will be accepted due to the friendly and friendly nature of this event, and **outside of any competitive spirit.** Each participant undertakes to respect without reserve the articles of these regulations and the directives imposed by the organizer. Only the French settlement is admissible during a dispute.
